## COLUMBIA VINEYARDS HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION Pool Rules

The pool is intended for the use and enjoyment of all Vineyards residents. Please keep in mind that this is not a public pool, and that it is the responsibility of all residents to enforce and follow these rules. By using the pool, you agree to follow these rules and share responsibility for upholding them with your fellow residents. For safety, courtesy, and liability reasons, the following rules are to be followed:

- 1. THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY AT ANY TIME. Please enter the pool area at your own risk.
- 2. Pool hours are from 6:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. Any person in the pool area outside of these designated hours is considered to be trespassing. Code of Ordinances, City of Columbia, Missouri § 16-156.
- 3. Residents must be at least 14 years of age to enter the pool area without an adult resident (over the age of 18). The adult resident is responsible for the behavior of accompanying children at all times.
- 4. All non-resident guests, regardless of age, must be accompanied by an adult resident (over the age of 18) at all times. Non-resident guests are limited to five (5) per family, per visit. The adult resident is responsible for the behavior of all accompanying non-resident guests at all times. A NON-RESIDENT PRESENT IN THE POOL AREA WITHOUT AN ADULT RESIDENT IS CONSIDERED TO BE TRESPASSING. Code of Ordinances, City of Columbia, Missouri § 16-156.
- 5. Keep the gate closed and locked at all times. The pool area is to be accessed by resident key fob only. The HOA will issue one key fob per home. The key fob will be deactivated if a home has any unpaid dues, fines, or assessments to the Association, or if a home is found to be in violation of the pool rules.
- 6. No diving, flips, running, pushing, dunking, fighting (physical or verbal) or excessive horseplay in the pool or pool area.
- 7. No food, beverages, or gum allowed in the pool or within three (3) feet of the pool. Food and beverage containers must be disposed of in the provided trash receptacles. GLASS CONTAINERS ARE PROHIBITED FROM THE POOL AREA.
- 8. NO SMOKING IN THE POOL OR POOL AREA AT ANY TIME.
- 9. Alcoholic beverages are allowed on the lower pool deck only. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the upper pool deck. No intoxication is allowed in the pool or pool area at any time. GLASS CONTAINERS ARE PROHIBITED FROM THE POOL AREA.

- 10. No disposable or cloth diapers in the pool; swim diapers are required for all children who are not fully potty-trained. PLEASE DO NOT DISPOSE OF DIAPERS IN THE POOL AREA. ALL WET AND/OR SOILED DIAPERS MUST BE TAKEN WITH A RESIDENT WHEN LEAVING THE POOL AREA.
- 11. Do not enter the pool if you have a communicable disease or open cut or wound; no band-aids are allowed in the pool.
- 12. No animals are allowed in the pool area.
- 13. Appropriate swimwear is required at all times; no cutoffs, thongs, pants, shorts, or excessively revealing attire will be permitted.
- 14. No profanity or offensive language; no attire with offensive language or pictures.
- 15. The use of radios, music players, game consoles, and other electronic devices is limited to headphones only.
- 16. PLEASE HELP KEEP THE BATHROOMS CLEAN.
